1. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

WN welcomed all to the meeting and confessed that he had not done a great deal since the Area AGM, however, he had visited Newmarket on Tuesday 24th April!

Newmarket Table needs much support during the coming year. At present they only have five active Tablers and whilst they have focused recent meetings on their 50th Charter which they plan to celebrate in December 2008 and also their Christmas meal for December 2007, there has not been much focus on lifting the numbers of members at present. During the course of the evening discussion focused briefly on the pantomime horse race that Newmarket Table had previously organised with the Newmarket Racecourse and this was raised again as a possibility. Chris Wilson, the Newmarket Chairman, was due to look into and get back to WN prior to Area Meeting. Further chasing is required.

In a brainstorm of potential candidates Jonathan Gouch of Ipswich 240, Ian Gorham of Ipswich Greyfriars, Stuart Davies of Sudbury were mentioned. A willing volunteer is required and further discussion is required with all Tables.

8. 41 LIAISON REPORT

Robert Adams contacted Ian McKenzie who put him in contact with David Roach. David is an ex Haverhill Tabler but now the National 41 Representative.

When 41 Club was set up they chose to have regions that did not overlap with Table areas but this is being changed during 2007/08 so that the links can be strengthened between Table and 41 Club. The intention is that Round Table Area 6 and Round Table Area 41 will equate with 41 Club Region 17. David currently looks after three regions and this will reduce to two. He is the sole point of contact with the 64 tables in his three regions, there not being a Regional Executive.

The National Councillor is a three year appointment and can serve a maximum of two terms. The appointment of Rob Adams as 41 club liaison officer gives a tremendous resource advantage to David in strengthening the link, and furthering the tabling experience in Area 41.

41 Club has a wide disparity of ages from 45 through to 87 in the Haverhill Club alone. The younger end of the spectrum want to carry on activities similar to the Table rather than just necessarily being a dining/dieing club and this is leading to some 41 Clubs either splitting into a 41 Active and a 41 Club or more active new 41 Clubs forming.

Generally there is a good overlap between 41 Club and Tables within the area. Sudbury could be better. Saffron Walden is backed up well by 41 Club for the carnival. Ipswich is supported by a single joint 41 Club. It is not known about Colchester as they are not in 41 Club Region 17, but they will be in the future. Cambridge has a strong 41 club, but no table, but this may be an opportunity for Newmarket.

It was confirmed that Rob Adams should contact all existing Tables to identify past Tablers who have left in the past five years with a view of putting them in contact with the local 41 Club en masse and working with David Roach to see if this can stimulate 41 Clubs. The priority should be the 41 Clubs for which we have feeder Tables rather than the 41 Clubs where there is no active Table today.
